- A minimum of 2 GCSEs at grade 6, 2 x GCSEs at grade 5, 2 GCSEs at grade 4 including English Language and Maths
- Additional course requirements must also be met

#### **MIXED STUDY (2 YEARS)**

- A minimum of 2 GCSEs at grade 5 and 3 GCSEs at grade 4 or above including English Language **and** Maths
- Additional course requirements must also be met

#### T LEVEL (2 YEARS)

- A minimum of 5 GCSEs at grade 4 or above including English Language and Maths
- Additional course requirements must also be met

#### FULL TIME VOCATIONAL LEVEL 3 (2 YEARS)

- A minimum of 5 GCSEs\* at a grade 4 or above including English Language and a minimum of a grade 3\*\* in GCSE Maths for the following courses:
  - o Business
  - o Forensic Science
  - Health & Social Care
- A minimum of 4 GCSEs\* at a grade 4 or above including English Language and a minimum of a grade 3\*\* Maths for the following courses:
  - o Public Services
  - Sports Coaching
  - Sports Coaching (Football with CITC)

#### LEVEL 2 FOUNDATION (1 YEAR)

• A minimum of 4 GCSEs\* at grade 3 or above including a grade 4 in English Language or Maths

A student who has not achieved a minimum of a Grade 4 in Maths or English Language (and has satisfied entry reas for their chosen L3 course) will be enrolled on to an appropriate Maths or English course alongside their Level 3 study programme
