



GCSE MATHS

Who is the course for?

This course is for anyone wishing to gain a grade 4 (equivalent to a grade C) or above in their GCSE Mathematics. Linear exam papers (covering both calculator and non calculator) at foundation level will be taken at the end of the course (May/June).

What does the course involve?

The GCSE Mathematics course involves 30 weeks of intensive study covering topics on Handling Data, Number, Algebra and Shape & Space.

Entry Requirements

- Anyone wishing to enrol must attend an assessment session prior to the start of the course and must achieve a satisfactory score.
- A willingness to work hard, attend each week, complete set work, revise thoroughly for exams and enjoy the experience of learning.



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Want to know more about the course?

The course covers topics in:

- Handling Data - averages, different types of graphs, questionnaires and probability
- Number – percentages, ratio, decimals and fractions
- Algebra – simplifying algebraic expressions and solving equations
- Shape and space – angles, area, volume

The exam consists of 3 papers, one non-calculator paper and two calculator papers.

How long does the course take?

1 academic year (September to June).

How much does it cost?

GCSE maths is FREE if you do not already hold a GCSE grade A*-C or 9-4.
