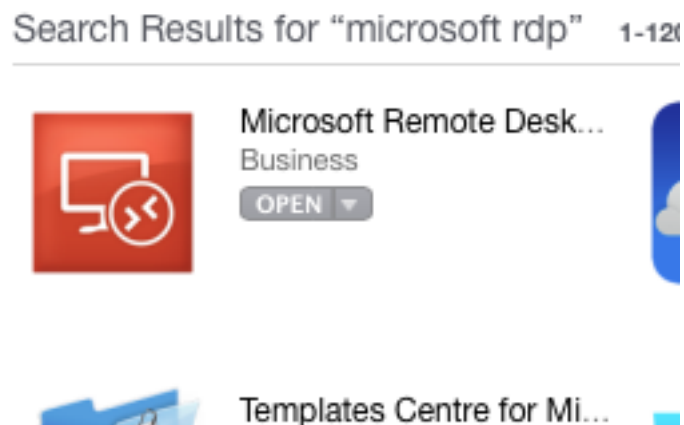


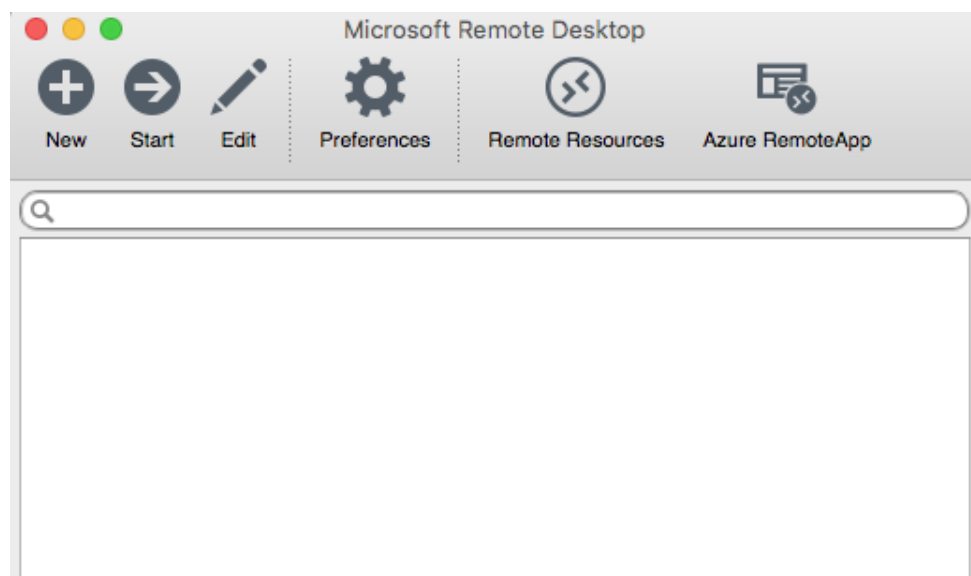
# Accessing Your Ashton Desktop from a Mac

You will first need to download an app from the app store called Microsoft Remote Desktop.


If you search for 'Microsoft RDP' in the app store it should be the top result.



Install and open it and you should see a window similar to the next shot.



Click on the 'Remote Resources' icon





Enter the information in the fields as above – substitute your logon name (usually your initials or similar) for ebr and click 'Refresh'. You should see the following

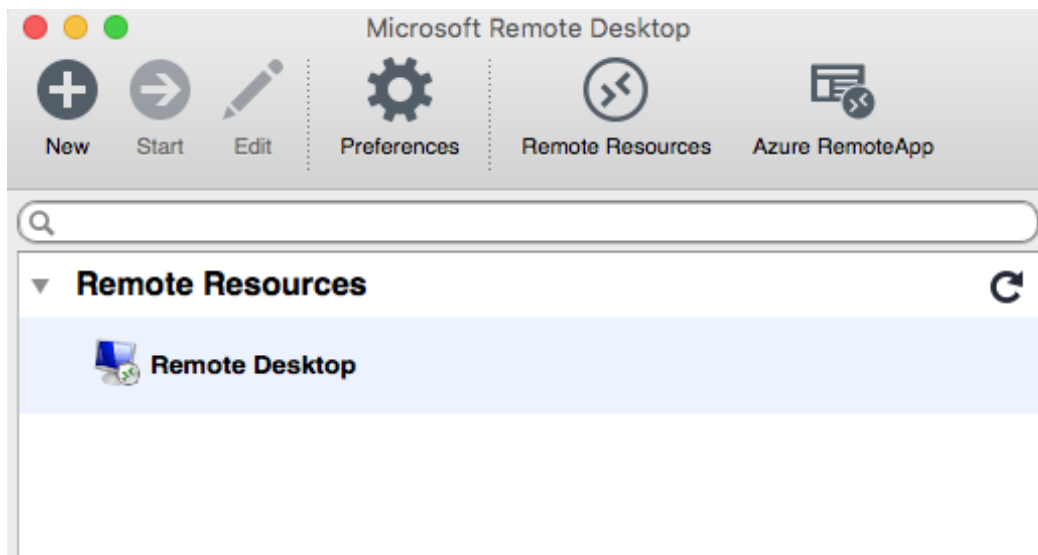

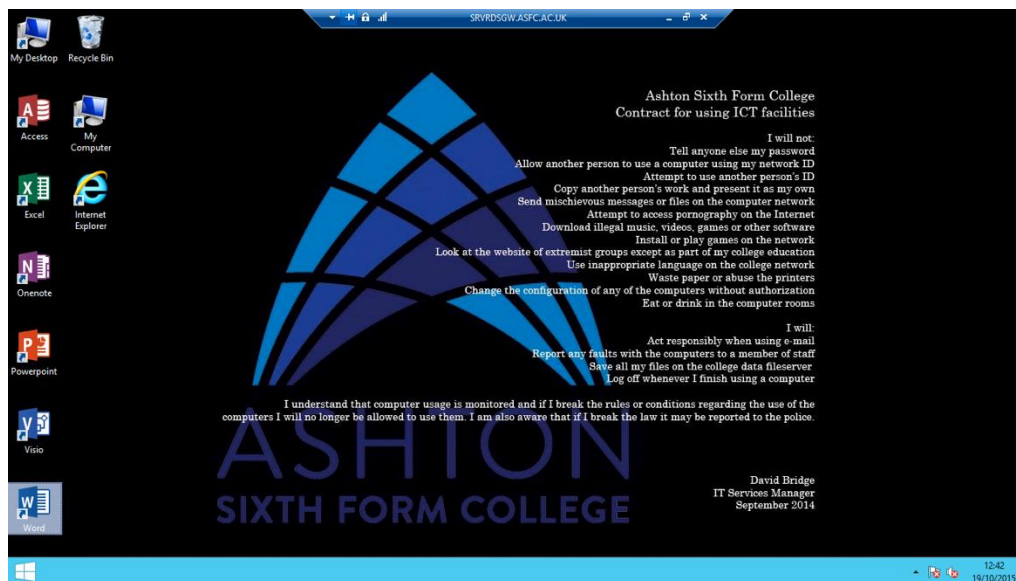
Close this window by clicking on the Red X at the top left and you should see the following (the previous setup steps are only needed the first time you use the app).



Double click the Remote Desktop Icon and your Ashton Remote Desktop should launch.

You should see a window open which contains your Ashton Desktop as if you were logged in to an Ashton Networked machine.

If working at home, any home printers connected to your computer should be available as an option if you want to print from the Remote Desktop.



When finished click on the Windows icon at the bottom left of the screen, then click on your username at the top right of the screen that appears and click Sign Out.
